Details About The COVID-19 2nd Shot (4th Dose)

[Eligibility:]

People aged 60 and older who received the 1st COVID-19 booster shot (3rd dose) more than 5 months ago.

People aged 18 and older with underlying heath conditions who are greenlighted by their doctors to receive the 2nd booster.

[Underlying Conditions]

- 1. Chronic Respiratory Diseases
- 2. Chronic Heart Diseases (High Blood Pressure)
- 3. Chronic Kidney Diseases
- 4. Chronic Liver Diseases (Except Fatty Liver and Chronic Hepatitis)
- 5. Diabetes Requiring Insulin Shots or Medicines for Treatment, or Diabetes with Complications
- 6. Blood Diseases (Except Iron-Deficiency Anaemia)
- 7. Immunodeficiency Diseases (Including a Malignant Tumour under Treatment)
- 8. In Treatment with Steroid or Other Drugs that Could Weaken the Immune System
- 9. Nervous Disorders or Neuromuscular Disorders Caused by Abnormalities of the Immune System
- 10. Weakened Body Function due to Neuropathy or Neuromuscular Diseases (Respiratory Failure, etc.)
- 11. Chromosome Abnormality
- 12. Server Multiple Disabilities (Simultaneous Server Physical and Intellectual Disabilities)
- 13. Sleep Apnoea Syndrome
- 14. Serious Psychological Disorder
- 15. Persons Whose BMI (Body Mass Index) Is 30.0 or Higher (within the Obese Range)
 - **BMI = Weight (kg)÷Height (m)÷Height (m) *One kilogram is approx. 2.204 pounds
 - Examples of a BMI of 30: Height 170 cm (approx. 5.58 feet) and weighs 87 kg (approx. 198 lbs) Height 160 cm (approx. 5.25 feet) and weighs 77 kg (approx. 170 lbs)

[How People With Underlying Conditions Should Apply For A COVID-19 Vaccine Ticket For The 2nd Booster Shot]

An application form, proof that the third dose was administered, and a photocopy of identification are required to be submitted through one of the following ways.

- By Post (Mailing Address: 522-0057, Shiga, Hikone, Hassaka-cho, 1900-4, Kusunoki Center 2F, COVID-19 Vaccination Management Office)
- Online (Scan the QR code on the right.)
- In Person (Visit the Hikone Health Promotion Division at Kusunoki Center with required documents.)



Information

★Be Sure To Enrol In The National Pension After Turning 20

It is compulsory for everyone aged from 20 to 60 living in Japan, regardless of nationality, to enrol in the National Pension System. A notice of the national pension enrolment will be mailed from the Japan Pension Service to all individuals who have turned 20 recently.

• Pension Contribution Exemption for Students

Students whose previous year's total income was under a certain threshold can apply for the pension contribution exemption. If accepted, pension contributions from April of the current year until March of the next year will be exempt. An application for the pension contribution exemption for students can be filed up to two years and one month retrospectively.

Please visit the pension office, Hikone Insurance and Pension Division, or any branch office of the city hall to complete the necessary paperwork. Make sure to bring your student ID card or school enrolment certificate when applying for this exemption system.

★Welfare Medical Support System

Under the welfare medical support system, medical support benefits are offered to the following persons. If you think you qualify, please contact Hikone Insurance and Pension Division for further details.

- · Children Aged 0 to 6
- 1st to 3rd Graders (outpatient costs and hospitalization)
- 4th to 9th Graders (hospitalization)
- People with Mental/Psychological Disabilities
- · Single Parents
- Widows Living Alone (under 74 years old)
- · Low-Income Earners (65 to 74 years old)
- *There are some income caps and terms for this welfare medical support system.
- *Please inquire what documents are required to be submitted, etc. from the relevant division of the Hikone city hall.
- *No benefits under the welfare medical support system will be provided for hospital meals and other expenses that are not covered by health insurance.

*Saturday Bulk Waste and Small Household Appliances Collection at the Hikone Sanitation Center

Important Notes:

- · You will be asked to show your identification to confirm that you are a resident of Hikone at the gate.
- Only bulk waste and small household appliances will be accepted that day.
- · Bulk waste will be collected for a fee.
- Small household appliances that are less than one meter in width, height, and depth will be collected free of charge.
- Unbroken fluorescent tubes, light bulbs, etc. will be also collected that day.
- Disposal of TVs, refrigerators, air conditioners, and washing machines are not collected at the center.
- Please follow instructions given by sanitation center workers to avoid disrupting the flow of waste disposal.

★Beware of Food Poisoning!

Here are some tips to prevent food poisoning as the rainy and summer seasons are approaching.

- Make a habit of washing hands before cooking, touching meat, fish, and eggs, before eating and while cleaning up after a meal.
- · Clean kitchen knives and cutting boards thoroughly each time, and use different kitchen utensils for meat, fish, and vegetables.
- · Refrigerate perishable food as soon as possible after purchasing it.
- Eat cooked dishes as quickly as possible as food can go off even while kept in a fridge.
- · Be sure to cook food well for safety.
- Be sure to heat food well when using a microwave.
- Disinfect kitchen knives, cutting boards, kitchen towels, etc. in boiling water and dry them well.

^{*}From the standpoint of COVID-19 mitigation, only one adult is allowed to accompany a child during the check-up.

^{*}For the 3 1/2 years old check-up, please bring a urine sample taken on the day of the check-up stored in a sanitized container.
