

Notice Regarding the Eligibility Confirmation of the One-off Cash Benefits Program

Please be notified that a cash handout of 30,000 yen is set to be provided to households exempt from fiscal year 2024 resident tax under the Japanese government's economic policy.

An additional 20,000 yen per child will be added to the cash benefit for eligible households with children aged under 18 years.

For this reason, your household is now required to confirm whether your household is eligible for the cash benefit payment, and if eligible, please provide all the required information on the confirmation form (B2).

Please submit the confirmation form along with a photocopy of your bankbook or bank card and your photo identification by May 30 (Fri).

If we do not receive your household's submission by the deadline, your household will be automatically considered to have withdrawn from the One-off Cash Benefits Program.

To avoid this, ensure that you submit the form and other required documents well in advance of the deadline.

Benefit Payment Schedule: It takes more or less a month after your submission is approved.

Payment Date: March 14 (Fri), March 21 (Fri), March 28 (Fri), April 3 (Thu), April 17 (Thu)

No notice regarding the completion of the benefit payment will be mailed. Please update your bankbook to confirm if the payment has been deposited.

*If your household has any children aged under 18 (born after April 2, 2006) and is eligible for additional 20,000 JPY, the name of each child is listed below.

[Eligibility Criteria] Households, that meet all the following criteria, qualify for the one-off cash benefit payment.

①All household members must be exempt from fiscal 2024 resident tax, including Kintowari (head tax) resident tax.

2 Households that are not eligible for any cash benefits from other municipalities under the same and similar programs.

3 No household members are exempt from taxes under the tax treaty.

④ Households that are not financially supported by someone subject to resident tax.

*To cite an example, a university student living alone and financially depending on his/her parents, tax-exempt parents financially supported by their child subject to resident tax, and those who joined the workforce in 2024, live alone, and are no longer covered by their parents' social security plans, are not eligible for this cash benefits program. If you are not sure, please consult with your family members or reach out to the call center at the number below.

• In order to verify eligibility, we may confirm details through public records or other sources.

• Beware that if you obtain the benefit payment by providing fraudulent and/or misleading information, you may face legal charges for benefit fraud.
