



Payment Notice: Supplemental Cash Benefit for Shortfalls in the Flat-Rate Tax Cut

This supplemental cash benefit is provided to qualifying taxpayers, based on their total income and tax cut information for fiscal year 2024, in order to address shortfalls in the initial Flat-Rate Tax Deduction program.

The amount of the benefit payment, provided to you shown below, has been calculated based on your income tax and resident tax for fiscal year 2024. Please note that the benefit amount will be deposited into the following bank account automatically; therefore, **there is no need for you to apply, unless you wish to renounce your eligibility or use a different bank account.**
