*Before Seeing a Doctor, Make a Call! (COVID-19)

As the weather gets colder and dryer, regular colds and influenza will become more common. Since early symptoms of a cold, flu and COVID-19 are hard to distinguish, if you have cold-like symptoms like a fever and want to see a doctor, please take the following steps to minimize the further spread of the pandemic.

①Contact Your Family Doctor or a Medical Clinic in Your Neighbourhood via Phone.

If you have such symptoms as a fever, sore throat, headache, diarrhoea, tiredness, and loss of smell and taste, make sure to call your doctor before visiting a medical clinic.

②Follow Instructions Given by Your Family Doctor.

In order to avoid close contact with others, you may be directed to come to a medical clinic in a specific way at a designated time.

③Take Every Precaution You Can Against COVID-19 When Seeing a Doctor.

Hand sanitizing, hand washing, and mask wearing are a must for you and anyone accompanying you. If your family doctor does not have enough equipment to test you for both flu and COVID-19, you will be referred to a different local clinic or hospital where you can get tested.

NB:

1: The Hikone Sanitation Centre is expected to be crowded during the new-year holiday season. For this reason, when bringing large-sized garbage directly to the Sanitation Centre, make sure to separate large-sized garbage in a proper manner, and be ready to dispose of it swiftly at the center. To avoid the expected crowds, you are strongly advised to bring large-sized garbage to the center as early as possible during the holiday season.

- 2: As for landfill trash, before going to the Nakayama Dumping Site, you need to get a disposal permit from the Hikone Sanitation Centre, the Living Environment Division or any branch office of Hikone City Hall by December 28, Monday. (You can obtain a permit from the temporary window of the city hall on December 29 and 30.)
- 3: Hikone's Night Soil Treatment service is available until December 30. There will be no service available from December 31 through January 3. If an urgent emergency which requires a night soil treatment service comes up, please directly contact a company.
- 4: If you have any questions regarding the schedule, please contact us at 0749-22-1411.
- 5: The hall of Hikone is scheduled to be closed from December 29 (Tue) through January 3 (Sun). During the period of the city hall's New Year holiday closure, no certificates can be issued at the city hall. Please ensure to visit the city hall before the 28th if you need any certificates. Our convenience store service (the issuance of tax-related, residence, certificates etc. is available by using a plastic My Number card) will also be unavailable from December 29 until January 3.
- 6: Filing a notification of childbirth, death (the issuance of a cremation permit is available between 8:30 and 5:15), divorce, etc. can be done even during the year-end and new-year holidays. For more information, please inquire with city officials at a temporary window of the city hall during the New Year holiday season.
- 7: Regarding Hikone's public water services, starting and cancelling the water supply and making a payment for your water bills are available at the Water and Sewerage Customer Service Center (Asahi-cho 1-22). Its opening hours are between 9:00 and 5:00.

Payments for the Hikone residential tax, national health insurance, night soil treatment, public water, sewer service, and so on, can be made at banks designated by the city. (Please check the opening schedules of each bank.) If your payment bill can be paid at a convenience store, you can do so through a mobile payment app such as PayPay、LINE Pay、 au PAY、 Pay B, etc.

1. Registration with Hikone's Emergency Email System (available in Japanese only) This system is to send emails about a missing person to all registered mobile devices. To register your email address for this system, please scan the QR code on the right.



- 2. Cooperation with Neighbors
 - Having a supportive relationship with your neighbors could lead you to find a missing person quickly.
- 3. Small Things to Ensure the Safety of the Elderly

Taking photos of your elder family member regularly, writing down his/her name on his/her belongings, having him/her carry a GPS device, etc. can provide extra safety. You can also register your elderly family member with dementia with the city hall of Hikone as a person at risk of going missing. A small registration sticker which can be attached to a shoe will be provided.

If you see someone walking aimlessly at night, wearing clothes unfit for the current season, pajamas, or no shoes, please talk to that person nicely to check if everything is okay. Your small action could save that person's life.



☆Protect a Water Pipe Against the Cold of Winter

*How to prevent frozen water pipes.

Please wind lagging materials around a water pipe. When you use blankets or clothes, please cover them with plastic tape.

*If you notice a frozen water pipe

Please put a towel on the frozen pipe and pour lukewarm water on it to melt the ice.

Don't pour on hot water. There is a danger that the water pipe will burst.

*If the water pipes burst.

Please close a valve in the water meter box and repair the leak with plastic tape. Call the designated water-supply utility to ask for the pipe to be repaired. Regarding the designated water-supply utility, please check Hikone City Homepage The repairing cost must be met by the person who asked for the repair.

*Check for water leaks

Check your water meter regularly to find water leaks early!

- 1. Turn off all faucets on the premises
- 2. Check the movement of the pilot needle of the water meter

If the pilot needle is moving, there is may be a water leak.

*About the Norovirus (Prevention from Norovirus Food Poisoning)

Norovirus outbreaks occur in the cold season, especially from November to February. This virus is extremely contagious. Even a small amount of contact can infect individuals and become active in the intestines. Infections occur when the virus enters the body through the mouth.

How to get infected

-Eating food made by someone infected -Raw or undercooked Clams

Most common symptoms

The incubation period is 24 to 48 hours (36 hours average).

-Nausea and vomiting -Stomach pains -Diarrhea -Fever

How to protect yourself from the norovirus?

Wash your hands

Hand washing with soap and water for at least 30 seconds reduces the transmission of norovirus pathogens before and after cooking, eating and using the toilet.

Do not share a towel.

•Heat food thoroughly

Cook the center above 85°C for over 90 seconds.

•Disinfecting kitchenware with care

Please disinfect your kitchenware with hot water or chlorine bleach before cooking.

•How to dispose of vomit and diarrhea

The virus could spread everywhere in the house from vomiting and diarrhea.

Protecting yourself from infection such as by wearing a mask and rubber gloves.

Cover the waste with paper towels soaked in a disinfectant solution of 0.02% concentration.

Pick up the waste and throw it away into the plastic bag.

Wipe the area where the waste was a few times with a paper towel soaked with the disinfectant solution and wipe with water again.

- •How to make a disinfectant solution
- $\mathbf{\nabla}$ 0.02% of sodium chlorate disinfectant solution

2 caps of a plastic bottle of chlorine bleach (10ml) and add water up to 2 liters.

 $\mathbf{\nabla}$ 0.1% of sodium chlorate disinfectant solution

50ml of chlorine bleach and add water up to 2 liters.

*X*It's convenient if you use a 2L PET bottle.

* Label the bottle as a disinfect solution in case you decide to keep it.
