



★Benefit System to Support Pensioners

This system will grant additional monetary support to pensioners whose income is below a specified amount. Prompt applications are appreciated

Eligible Persons

- Persons living on a pension who meet the following conditions.
 - 1 Older than 65 years old
 - 2 All family members living under the same household are untaxed
 - 3 Total annual income (pension + other income sources) is below \(\frac{1}{2}\)879,900.
- · Recipients of Disability Pension or Bereavement Pension

Previous year's income is under \(\frac{\pma}{4}\),621,000 + (number of your dependents(s)) x \(\frac{\pma}{3}\)80,000

★Vaccination Subsidy Program for Seasonal Influenza

A great number of seasonal influenza cases were reported during the last winter season. Given that COVID-19 is still a growing concern, the city of Hikone is set to kick off its subsidy program for influenza vaccination for those who are listed on Hikone City's basic resident registration at the time of getting vaccinated and meet the following conditions given in the table below.

Vaccination Site: Depending on the age of a person, where to get a flu shot differs. Please see the table below and check which medical facility you need to go to.
