## **☆Information on a COVID-19 Vaccine Rollout**

As of now, preparations for Japan's COVID-19 vaccine rollout are being made in Hikone with the aim that all residents of Hikone can receive their doses in a safe and effective manner.

The following information on the COVID-19 vaccine rollout was issued as of February 18 (Thu). Please stay informed on the COVID-19 vaccine rollout in Hikone by regularly checking the official website of Hikone, the foreign-language Facebook page, and the newsletter.

#### **Vaccination Timetable**

Any details on a concrete start date of the COVID-19 vaccines have not been fully decided yet.

The COVID-19 vaccines will be administered in different phases at different times.

At the moment, COVID-19 vaccine priority groups are listed as follows from top (1) to bottom (4).

- 1, Healthcare Workers (Scheduled for around March)
- 2, Seniors Age 65 and Older (Scheduled for around April)
- 3, People with Underlying Health Conditions and Adult Day-care Workers
- 4, Remaining Members of the Public

#### Doses of the COVID-19 Vaccine

The COVID-19 vaccine requires two doses to fully inoculate an individual.

The second dose will be shot 3 to 4 weeks after the first dose.

#### **Vaccination Fees**

The COVID-19 vaccines will be distributed for all free of charge.

Vaccination tickets are scheduled to be mailed out according to different phases and tiers.

#### **Vaccination Sites**

The city is now working with medical facilities in Hikone and public facilities (Kusunoki Center, etc.) to carry out the city-wide vaccination rollout.

#### **Frequently Asked Questions**

· Can Children or Pregnant Women Get Vaccinated?

At the moment, the central government of Japan is reviewing COVID-19 vaccine eligibility for all age groups.

The approved COVID-19 vaccine is manufactured by Pfizer and available for people age 16 and older.

It is possible for pregnant women and women who are breastfeeding to get vaccinated; however, please make your decision based on the facts about efficacy and safety of the vaccine.

· Can I Receive the Vaccine Outside Hikone?

As long as you are listed on Hikone's basic resident registration, you are required to receive the vaccine in Hikone. Only with a special reason, could you be permitted to receive the vaccine in the city where you live now.

- I Am Living in a Nursing Home Outside Hikone. What Should I Do?

  You can get your vaccine administered by a doctor of the nursing home or at a medical facility of your current city.
- How Should I Schedule My Vaccine Appointment?
  All vaccination appointments can be made via a call centre or the Internet.

## **☆Garbage Collection Calendar to be Distributed**

The Hikone Garbage Collection Calendar of the fiscal year 2021 will be distributed along with Hikone Community Newsletter in Japanese. Foreign-language versions (English, Chinese and Portuguese) are available at the Hikone Sanitation Centre, the Hikone Living Environment Division, and each branch office of the Hikone city hall.

#### ★Disposal of Large-size Garbage: 8:00 a.m. - 11:00 a.m., Sunday, March 28

- A Please wait at the parking lot of Hikone Bunka Plaza. The staff will lead you.
- B You cannot take garbage directly to the Sanitation Center.
- C To reduce traffic congestion, please do not come before 8:00 a.m.
- D The designated collection time is irregular this time.
- E Please show your identification, such as a driver's license or residence card to show your address.
- F The disposal of large-size garbage is charged. However, household small appliances under one meter in length, width and depth are not charged.
- F Unbroken light bulbs and florescent tubes will be accepted.
- G TVs and other products subject to the Home Appliance Recycling Act are not accepted.

# **★Relocation of the Designated Landfill Site**

Please be informed that the designated landfill site, "Nakayama Touki Jo" will not be available after March 31, 2021. After that date, please take your landfill waste to the landfill site "Koyagi Chukei Kichi" for a fee (5 kg or 11 lbs / ¥50). The address is 19 Koyagi-cho, Higashi Ohmi City. Be sure to apply for a landfill permit in advance.

To ease possible long wait time and crowdedness, the city hall of Hikone is scheduled to open on March 14 (Sun), 28(Sun) and April 11(Sun) between 9:30 a.m. and 1:00 p.m..

Services available on Sundays at the City Hall

- apply for government-issued certificate such as a residence and family registry certificate.
- · do your moving-in/our procedures and change addresses within Hikone.
- register your *Inkan* and apply for an *Inkan* registration certificate.
- receive a plastic My Number card or update your plastic My Number card.
- \*Please note that there are a few services unavailable, and no English or other language interpreters will be stationed during the Sunday opening.

#### **★My Number Card and Health Insurance Card**

From the month of March, your plastic My Number card can also hold information of your health insurance coverage. Depending on the type of your health insurance coverage, you may not be able to use this My Number card feature. For more information, please call 0120-95-0178.

#### Benefits of Inputting Your Health Insurance Info into Your Plastic My Number Card



You will no longer have to wait for your new social insurance card to be issued after getting employed, changing jobs, moving to a different city and so on.

#### 2. Wait Time at a Medical Facility Can Be Shortened

By having your My Number card scanned by a card reader at a reception desk of a medical clinic or pharmacy, your health insurance information will be smoothly processed and your whole wait time can be shortened.

#### 3. No Need to Make a Temporary Payment for the Amount That Exceeds the Maximum Co-payment Amount

Even without a *Gendogaku Tekiyo Ninteisho* (Certificate of Eligibility for Reduced Co-Payments), your My Number card enables you to not cover the amount that exceeds the maximum co-payment amount.

#### **Easy Application!**

To register your health insurance information in your My Number card, please apply via Myna Portal.

You need your My Number card and your smart phone which can scan the card.





#### **★Child Medical Support Program (Hospitalization)**

This support program provides subsidies for hospitalization expenses (for the self-pay expenses of insurance coverage costs) for fourth grade students in elementary school up to third grade students in junior high school. The medical expenses are paid you back after paying the fee at the medical institution and applying for a refund at a municipal office. Please contact us for further information.

- \*No notice issued. The period you can apply is within 5 years from the next day you paid.
- \*There are some exceptions, such as the meal expenses during hospitalization, that insurance doesn't cover.
- \*This program gives priority to the support program for single parent families and the disabled.

#### Things you need to apply

The original receipt, Hanko (a name seal), a bankbook, health insurance certificate of the child, a notice of *Kougaku Iryou* (High-cost medical care benefit) or other related letter, etc.

#### ★Spring Traffic Campaign for New School Children & Seniors: Mon March 15 – Thu April 15

# **★Support of German Measles Vaccination Expenses**

People who already received a German measles antibody test by Shiga prefecture can get support.

Time limit: March 31 (Wednesday)

Eligibility (Those who meet all of the following)

- 1. Those who have had a German measles antibody test between March 1, 2020 and March 31, 2021.
- 2. Those who have been advised by their doctor to have a German measles vaccination after the antibody test.
- 3. Those who have had a German measles vaccination between April 1, 2020 and March 31, 2021 after the antibody test

The amount of support: half of the amount of the charge is supported (maximum 5,000 yen)

## **★Support of Infertility Treatment Expenses**

## Support of specific infertility treatment expenses

Eligibility (Those who meet all of the following)

- OHusband and wife who live in the city at the time of medical treatment and application, and are legally married
- oThose who have received Shiga specific infertility treatment expense support
- OHusband and wife who are not behind with municipal tax

**The amount of support**: Specific infertility treatment expenses is supported.

The amount of support is limited to 50,000yen. Please don't overlap with the Shiga specific infertility treatment subsidy.

#### In the following cases, 25,000 yen will be supported.

\*Embryo transplantation by using frozen embryos

\*When treatment is stopped because patients cannot get egg in spite of ovulating.

#### Support of artificial insemination expenses

Eligibility (Those who meet all of the following)

- OHusband and wife who live in the city at the time of a medical treatment and application, and are legally married
- Husband and wife's income in the last financial year is less than 7,300,000 yen.
- OHusband and wife who are not behind with municipal tax

**The amount of support**: Half of the amount of the charge is supported.

For a total of two-years, the amount of money is a maximum of 50,000 yen.

Time limit: March 31 Wednesday, 2021

If you get the treatment in March, you can apply until April 30 Friday 2021.

Infant check-ups for 10-month-old babies and 21/2-year-old children have been cancelled due to the Covid-19 pandemic. Instead of the infant check-ups, there is a child development consultation with a public health worker available for guardians. If you are interested, you need to make a booking in advance by calling the Health Promotion Division. Please check the schedule of the child development consultation below.

• For 10-month-old babies: March 17 (Wed)

• For 21/2-Years-old children: March 18 (Wed)

#### **☆Vaccination for Children Week March 1- March 7**

#### Has your child received every vaccination?

Please check your maternity passport if you have forgotten to receive any vaccinations for your child before entering school or kindergarten. You can make a reservation for a vaccination as early as possible in order to have resistance to illnesses and to prevent becoming ill.

You check the eligible age and make a reservation in advance for individual regular vaccinations such as Hib Vaccine, Pediatric Pneumococcal Vaccine, Hepatitis B Vaccine, DPT-IPV, BCG, MR, Chicken Pox, Japanese Encephalitis, and DT.

Fee: Free of charge (It costs you when you are over the recommended age)

Things to bring: Maternity passport, medical questionnaire.

#### Notice

The 2nd term of MR (Measles and German measles)

Eligibility: pre-school children (For those born between April 2, 2014 and April 1, 2015)

The 2nd term of DT (Diphtheria and Tetanus)

Eligibility: 6th grade students (For those born between April 2, 2008 and April 1, 2009)

Those eligible have already notified and received the documents.

\*Waccination period is up to March 31, 2021.

Japanese Encephalitis (free of charge)

- 1, Those born before April 1, 2007 and under 20 years old can get the remaining number of mandatory shots.
- 2, Those born between April 2, 2007 and October 1, 2009 can get a missing shot according to their vaccination record.

<sup>\*</sup>No reminder will be mailed to your address.

<sup>\*</sup>Please bring a toothbrush and a face towel for infant check-ups for 11/2 years old, and 31/2 years old.

<sup>\*</sup>For the 31/2 years old check-up, please bring your child's first morning urine sample stored in a sanitized container.

<sup>\*</sup>On the day of an infant check, please take the body temperature of your baby and anyone who accompanies him/her. And if you suspect that your child is sick, please contact the Health Promotion Division.
