### **★Mass COVID-19 Vaccination and Appointment**

From May 10 (Fri), Hikone is slated to accept applications for the COVID-19 vaccine.

Each eligible vaccine recipient is required to make a vaccine appointment. Please be aware that it will be difficult for many to schedule their vaccine appointment given that available vaccine doses are limited.

How to Make an Appointment (Choose one of the following ways)

- 1, Vaccination Website
- 2, Mobile Messaging Application LINE
- 3, Call Center

\*If you have any questions or want to book your vaccine slot via phone, please call the call center at 0120-152-811. (Operation days and hours: Weekdays, 8:30 AM – 5:00 PM)

The start day of Hikone's mass COVID-19 vaccination is scheduled for May 24 (Mon).

\*Please refrain from getting in touch with your family physician or any other local clinic to check whether they offer a jab individually or not.

### **★Rabies Vaccine for Dogs**

From April through May, rabies shots for dogs are made available at mass rabies vaccination sites within Hikone City. Just like last year, dog owners are allowed to have their dog(s) vaccinated for rabies by the end of this year due to the ongoing pandemic. If your dog has not received a rabies shot, please get in touch with your vet and make an arrangement for one.

### **★Information about Japan's Pension System**

- A Please sign up for National Pension System.
  - It is compulsory for all residents aged between 20 and 60 years old in Japan (foreign residents included) to sign up for the National Pension system. If you become unemployed or a non-dependent (e.g. after divorced, after earning over the threshold, etc.), you have to do some procedures at the Hikone Pension Office, Insurance and Pension Division or each branch office of the Hikone City Hall.
- B Special Exemption during Pregnancy
  - There is a special exemption system for women who are pregnant. The contribution payment will be exempted for four months from the previous month of due date or of childbirth (for multiple births, the exemption period is six months from three months before the month of due date or of childbirth. There are a few conditions each applicant has to meet to become eligible for this exemption system. For more details, please contact the Insurance and Pension Division.

### **★**Car Tax Reduction Scheme for People with Disabilities

For cars owned by people with physical and psychological, the car tax reduction scheme can be applicable after meeting certain conditions. Please note that this car tax reduction can apply to one car (either a Kei car or a regular-size vehicle) per person with disabilities.

- How to Apply: Please submit/show all requirements (see below) to the Hikone Tax Division, Japanese Tax Office, or Inae Branch Office of Hikone City Hall. You can mail the requirements by post, using a red letter envelope called "Letter Pack Plus."
- Requirements: An applicant's disability certificate (physical disabilities, mental disabilities, war injury and sickness, special education, etc.), driver's licence, a photocopy of a *Shaken* (car inspection) certificate, a bill/notice for a car tax, an applicant's My Number card, and an applicant's photo ID.
- \*Please note that depending on the disability grade, the amount of the tax reduction can differ.
- \*Please contact the Hikone Tax Division if a person who is not living under the same household but takes care of a disabled family member wants to apply for this car tax reduction scheme.
- \*Each applicant will be required to verify his/her own My Number numbers.

### **★The Changes of Conditions for Parking Permits for Wheelchair User**

Parking permits are issued to elderly citizens, people with disabilities and those who assist them such as long-term care workers. The conditions of eligible people and expiration date were changed in April as follows:

- ① Expiration date of physical disability certificate and intellectual disability certificate stated no recognition date is changed to <code>\indextrigorightarrow\infty</code> (It is not available to a person who has a certificate stated recognition date. The expiration date of this certificate remains for 5 years)
- ② Expiration date of "Parking permit" for expectant and nursing mothers is changed to the period from the time you receive a *Boshi Techo* to within a year after childbirth.
- ③ A person who has a grade 2 mental health welfare certificate is newly eligible.

Eligibility: physical disabilities, intellectual disabilities, mental disabilities, patients with incurable diseases, expectant and nursing mothers, people who have difficulty walking and need someone's care.

### **★Special Cash Handout for Low-Income Households with Children**

To alleviate the financial impact caused by COVID-19, the city office is set to provide financial assistance.

### 1. Single-parent households

¥50,000 per child until eighteen years old or under twenty years old child who has a greater-than-moderate disability.

- Eligibility (1) A single parent who received the *Jido Futo Teate* (Childcare Support Allowance) payment for April
  - (2) A single parent who is eligible for *Jido Futo Teate* because of receiving public pension payments.
  - (3) A single-parent household whose income has been impacted hard by COVID-19 and who falls into neither (1) nor (2).
  - \*Please note that those who became single parents by the end of March are eligible for this cash handout.
  - \*For those who fall into either (2) or (3), a certain income threshold applies to their eligibility.
- How to Apply: For those who fall into (1), there is no need to apply, and their cash handouts will be deposited into the same as the bank accounts for *Jido Fuyo Teate* around April 27.

For others, application forms will be mailed out in late May. Please note that the application period for this cash handout is scheduled to begin on May 21, 2021 and end on February 28, 2022.

### 2. Cash Handout for childrearing households who are untaxed

The city is currently waiting to receive more details from the central government of Japan with regard to this cash handout program. Once we get more concrete information and become ready to provide cash handouts for eligible households, we will inform you through our official Hikone website, Hikone community newsletter, etc.



In response to the start of Hikone's COVID-19 vaccination campaign, the Hikone Holiday Urgent Care Clinic (called Hikone Kyujitsu Kyubyou Shinryoujo in Japanese) is scheduled to close on Sundays from April 2021 through November 2021. We ask you for your understanding and support in this matter, and we sincerely apologize for any inconveniences this schedule change may cause.

- \* When it comes to pediatrics for children under the preschool age, please see a pediatrician at the urgent care center of the Hikone Municipal Hospital (*Shiritsu Byoin* in Japanese).
- \* For children in the 1<sup>st</sup> grade up to the 9<sup>th</sup> grade, please take him/her to the Hikone Holiday Urgent Care Clinic to pick up a permit, which is called "Shounika Shinryou Iraisho", before seeing a doctor. This permit can exempt guardians from paying fees for a first-time patient without a referral.

### **★Information of Routine Immunization for Babies**

Vaccinations are very important in order to have resistance to illness and prevent yourself and others from becoming ill. Before a child receives a vaccination, please check a *Boshi Techo* (child health and development record books) and read the description well. If you are not sure about the vaccination conditions, please consult with the City Health Promotion Division.

Rotavirus, BCG, PCV(Pneumococcal Vaccine), DTP-IPV(Diphtheria, Tetanus and Pertussis and Injectable Polio), MR(Measles and Rubella), Japanese Encephalitis, Chickenpox, Hib, HPV, Hepatitis B

#### · About Human Papilloma Virus vaccination

This vaccine is not currently recommended but you can receive the vaccination as part of Japan's routine immunization.

### ·In the case of getting a vaccination outside of Hikone City

If you wish your child to get vaccinated outside of Hikone City, you need to apply to Health Promotion Division in advance.



### How to get checkups

- 1. Make an appointment by the website.
- 2. Confirm the designated time in the letter sent about five days before the date of receipt.
- 3. Get checkups at the designated date.

### Fee:

Special Checkups: Free (please bring your ticket and insurance card), Health checkup: 1,300 yen Stomach, Colon, Breast, Uterine checkup: 500 yen, Lungs checkup: 300 yen

It is important to have regular cancer checkups. Stomach, lungs, and colon cancer should be checked every year and breast and uterine cancer should be checked every two years. Not all cancers can be detected by checkups. If you have any symptoms, please see a doctor immediately.

<sup>\*</sup>Please bring a toothbrush and a face towel for infant check-ups for 11/2 years old, and 31/2 years old.

<sup>\*</sup>For the 31/2 years old check-up, please bring a urine sample taken on the day of the check-up stored in a sanitized container.

<sup>\*</sup>On the day of an infant check, please take the body temperature of your baby and anyone who accompanies him/her. And if you suspect that your child is sick, please contact the Health Promotion Division.

<sup>\*2</sup> Welfare recipients between the ages of 40 and 74 years old and those who are aged between 19 and 39 years old.
