

*Changes to Public Services Offered at Civic Hall and Chuo-cho Temp Office

*The Special Cash Handout Program for Low-Income Households with Children

Given that the economic impact of COVID-19 persists, the city of Hikone is set to provide special cash handouts to lowincome households with children to alleviate their financial strain. This special cash handout program targets households with children that are not taxed by resident tax. (You can find information on the financial support program for single-parent households in the May issue of our community newsletter.)

[Targeted Children] *Primary conditions are as follows.

- Children born after April 2, 2001 who qualify for *Tokubetsu Jido Fuyo Teate* (Special Childrearing Allowance) or children born after April 2, 2003 who qualify for childrearing support programs other than *Tokubetsu Jido Fuyo Teate*.
- Children who are not targeted by any other cash handout program, living in Japan, and not being looked after at any facilities such as an orphanage, a nursing home for children with disabilities, a shelter, rehab facility, etc.

*Some other terms and conditions will apply. For more details, please visit the official website of Hikone City.

[Eligible Groups] If you belong to any of the following groups, you will qualify for this cash handout program.

- Group 1: Parents who received Tokubetsu Jido Fuyo Teate or Jido Teate for the month of April, 2021 and ARE EXEMPT FROM FY 2021 resident tax.
- Group 2: Parents who applied or will newly apply for *Tokubetsu Jido Fuyo Teate* or *Jido Teate* between May, 2021 and March, 2022 and ARE EXEMPT FROM FY 2021 resident tax.
- Group 3: Civil servants who receive *Jido Teate* or look after other children targeted by this cash handout program, such as a foster parent, and ARE EXEMPT FROM FY 2021 resident tax.
- Group 4: Parents of target children (see the above) who are taxed for FY 2021 resident tax but whose household income dropped to the same level as untaxed households due to the economic impact of COVID-19.
- Group 5: Parents who are looking after high-school aged children or children who are not targeted by *Jido Teate* and ARE EXEMPT FROM FY 2021 resident tax.

[Cash Handout Amount] 50,000 JPY per child (Note that this cash handout is a one-off payment.)

[How to Apply]

- Group 1: There is no need to apply. Eligible households can expect their one-off special cash handout payments to be paid into their bank accounts registered with the city.
- Group 2: There is no need to apply. If you are eligible, you will receive a notice from the city through the mail.
- Group 3: You will be notified by your workplace of what to do. Please contact us if you look after a child/children who is/are under 18 years old as you might be eligible for this cash handout program.
- Group 4 & 5: There is some paperwork to be done and is required to be submitted before you apply. Therefore, please contact us at the number below.

[Application Due Date] February 28 (Mon), 2022

*Those who will newly apply to receive a *Jido Teate* or *Tokubetsu Jido Fuyo Teate* payment from March, 2022, the due date for this special cash handout will be extended.

*Fiscal 2021, Application for National Pension Contribution Exemption/Payment Postponement

If you have financially difficulties with your pension contribution payments, you can apply for a contribution exemption or payment postponement.

NB: If you leave your balance for your pension contributions unpaid without making an application for contribution exemption or payment postponement, you may not be able to claim for a Basic Bereavement Pension or Disability Pension if an unexpected accident happens.

*You can apply retroactively up to two years one month

If you will discover a missing person, you can scan a QR code of his or her "*Mimamori Anshin* seal" and contact his or her family quickly through the "*Doko Shiru* message board" 24 hours a day, 365 days a year.

When you see an anxious looking person who is wearing the Mimamori Abshin seal, please speak kindly to them.

When the family of the old person wants to have a *Mimamori Anshin* seal, they must be registered with the Email Emergency Information system. Please send a blank e-mail message to touroku @ hikone-city. jp and register the searcher information of the missing old persons after receiving a reply via email with your temporary registration information.

☆Take Precaution Against Heat Stroke

Please be careful not to get heat stroke

Children, the elderly, and sick people are more likely to suffer from heat stroke.

In severe cases, it can lead to death.

Let's prevent heat stroke!

How to prevent heat stroke

- Drink plenty of water
- Wear breathable clothes
- Use air conditioners and fans
- Eat a well-balanced diet
- Use a hat and parasol
- Take a rest as soon as you feel sick

If you have any symptoms, suspect heat stroke.

Minor symptoms

Dizziness, muscle pains, sweating

Medium symptoms

Headache, nausea, tiredness, weakness

Severe symptoms

Unconsciousness, cramps, high fever, strange response to calls, inability to walk or run straight

Heat stroke alert

A heat stroke alert will be issued on the day before or on the day when there is a risk of heat stroke.

When a heat stroke alert is issued, please take the above preventive measures.

*No reminder will be mailed to your address.

*Please bring a toothbrush and a face towel for infant check-ups for 11/2 years old and 31/2 years old.

*For the 31/2 years old check-up, please bring a urine sample taken on the day of the check-up stored in a sanitized container.

*On the day of an infant check, please take the body temperature of your baby and anyone who accompanies him/her.

And if you suspect that your child is sick, please contact the Health Promotion Division.
