#### Keep Your Vaccine Ticket Safe Even After You Are Fully Vaccinated

As of now, there is no government-issued certificate certifying that you have been fully vaccinated against COVID-19 aside from the vaccine passport that excludes you from a mandatory quarantine in some foreign countries. Your vaccine ticket is the only formal verification document in this regard, and therefore, you are strongly advised to keep your vaccine ticket once you are fully vaccinated.



#### **About the Recommended Interval**

In principle, there has to be a two-week interval between the 1<sup>st</sup> dose and 2<sup>nd</sup> dose of the COVID-19 vaccination, and any other jab must not be administered during the interval. This recommended two-week interval is applicable in cases where a non-COVID-19 jab is administered after getting the 2<sup>nd</sup> dose of the COVID-19 vaccination.

#### **Combining Two Different COVID-19 Vaccines**

- If you wish to receive the AstraZeneca vaccine as your 2<sup>nd</sup> dose due to sever adverse reactions to the Pfizer or Moderna vaccine, please contact the Shiga AstraZeneca Vaccination Center. More details are available on the website of Shiga.
- If you wish to receive the Pfizer vaccine as your 2<sup>nd</sup> dose after having adverse reactions to the Moderna vaccine, please get in touch with the Hikone Appointment Call Center at 0120-152811. Note that terms and conditions apply.

#### **★Saturday Opening of Hikone Consultation Centre for Foreigners**


The Hikone consultation centre for foreigners (International Longue Salon) is scheduled to be open temporarily on November 20<sup>th</sup> (Saturday).

#### **☆Hepatitis Virus Test**

Test Day: November 30 (Tue)

Eligibility: Hikone Residents Aged Older Than 40 Years Old Who Have Never Got Tested For The Virus Before.

\*A notice regarding the hepatitis virus test was mailed to eligible people at the age of 40, 45, 50, 55, and 60 late May.

Appointment: If you received the notice, schedule your appointment for the test with one of the designated medical facilities. If you

do not have the notice but wish to get tested, please contact the Hikone Health Promotion division at 0749-24-0816.

Fee: Free with the notice, 1,300 yen with no notice

#### **★Cancer Screening**

The following cancer screening tests are available at medical facilities across Hikone at a reasonable price. For more information, please access the official website of Hikone.

#### Types of Cancer Screening

- Colorectal Cancer Available until December 20 \*A faecal sample container is available until November 30.
- · Breast Cancer Available until March 31, 2022
- · Cervical Cancer Available until March 31, 2022

How to Schedule a Cancer Screening Test

Please directly contact one of the designated medical facilities at your earliest convenience. A list of the designated facilities is available on the website of Hikone.





<sup>\*</sup>Please bring a toothbrush and a face towel for infant check-ups for 11/2 years old and 31/2 years old.

<sup>\*</sup>For the 31/2 years old check-up, please bring a urine sample taken on the day of the check-up stored in a sanitized container.

<sup>\*</sup>On the day of an infant check, please take the body temperature of your baby and anyone who accompanies him/her.
