NB:

- 1: Be sure to consult your trash collection calendar, and take out the trash to a trash collection spot by December 28 (Tue).
- 2: In terms of landfill waste, you need to request a permit issued by the Hikone Sanitation center, Living Environment division, or each branch office of the Hikone city hall before taking landfill waste to the Koyagi dumping site.
- 3: Hikone's night soil treatment service is available until December 30.
- 4: Please visit the city hall before the 28th if you need any certificates. The issue of certificates at government-issued convenience stores will be also unavailable from December 29 until January 3. Registering childbirth, death (the issue of a cremation permit is available between 8:30 and 5:15), divorce, etc. can be done at the city hall even during the year-end and new-year holiday period.
- 5: Regarding Hikone's public water services, starting and cancelling the water supply and making a payment for water bills are available at the Water and Sewerage Customer Service Center (1F, Hikone City Hall) between 9:00 and 5:00.
- 6: Payments for resident tax, national health insurance, night soil treatment, water, sewer service, and so on, can be made at banks designated by the city. (Please check the opening schedules of each bank.) If your payment bill can be paid at a convenience store, you can do so through a mobile payment app such as PayPay, LINE Pay, au PAY, Pay B, etc.

★December 1st Wednesday is "WORLD AIDS DAY"

In Japan, approximately three individuals test positive for HIV or AIDS on a daily basis. In Shiga alone, ten cases of HIV/AID positive are reported annually, and the prefecture has the highest percentage of AIDS cases among HIV positives in the Kinki region.

People infected with HIV do not feel sick for years. If people with HIV are not aware of their infection, they could unknowingly transmit the virus to others. To prevent the spread of HIV, it is crucial to detect HIV infection as early as possible.

The period of rabies vaccination is normally available between April 1 and June 30; however, due to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic, the rabies vaccination period has been extended until the end of this year (Dec 31, Fri). If you pet dog has not received any vaccines against rabies yet, please do so immediately.

★Year-End Nationwide Road Safety Campaign

From December 1 through 31, the road safety campaign is set to kick off across Shiga Prefecture.

Please be aware of the following to reduce the risk of possible road accidents.

• It gets dark earlier during the winter time.

Pedestrians and cyclists are advised to wear safety reflectors or bright color clothes to protect your own lives.

· Seat belts are your lifeline.

Make sure to buckle up every time you ride in a car regardless of a driver's seat, passenger's seat, front seat or back seat. Use of a child safety seat is a must for children under 6 years old.

· Alcohol consumption jumps around this time of year.

Driving under the influence is a serious crime. Do not be an alcohol-impaired driver or enabler!
