#### **★Updates on the COVID-19 Vaccination**

· Omicron-specific COVID-19 Vaccines

COVID-19 vaccines targeting the omicron variant have been recently approved by the Japanese government.

Omicron-specific vaccines are expected to be rolled out soon and can be administered to people aged over 12.

More information will be provided as soon as Hikone City gets supplies and instructions from the national government.

· Vaccines to Children Aged 5 to 11

The national government has approved a COVID-19 booster shot (third dose) for children aged 5 to 11 if more than five months have passed since their 2nd dose. To children who are eligible for a booster shot, a vaccine ticket and information documents will be mailed accordingly.

· Novavax Vaccine

Novavax vaccines can be administered to people over 12 as a first and second dose and can be administered to people over 18 as a booster shot. In Hikone City, there are a few places where you can get a Novavax vaccine. Please visit the Hikone City website for further details.

• Extension of Japan's COVID-19 Vaccination Campaign

The national government of Japan was initially due to end its COVID-19 vaccination campaign at the end of September; however, it has extended the campaign period until the end of March next year.

#### **☆Minimum Wage in Shiga Prefecture**

Staring October 6 Thursday, Shiga's minimum wage is set to rise to 927 yen per hour regardless of employment status (for example, a part-time worker, full-time worker, or contract worker). Please note that this minimum-wage hike applies to anyone working in Shiga Prefecture.

#### **☆October** is the Month of Nation-Wide Awareness of Food Loss

According to the national government, Japan wasted roughly 5 million tons of food in 2020. In another word, approximately 113 grams of food (equivalent to a bowl of rice) was wasted per capita each day throughout 2020.

Food loss involves everyone, so please try not to waste food.

#### **★Nursery School Application (Fiscal 2023)**

Ensure to check the following eligibility criteria before applying for a nursery school.

If one of the following applies to you, you are eligible to make an application.

#### [Eligibility Criteria]

- ①Parents working over 60 hours a month.
- ②A mother who is currently pregnant or in her postpartum period

  (Two months prior to the due date, up to six months after childbirth)
- ③Parents who have been diagnosed with a disease or mental illness or have been injured to the degree that they are unable to take care of themselves and their child.
- (4) Parents who regularly attend to their household member or family member who has been hospitalized.
- ⑤Properties such as a house which has sustained damage caused by a fire, storm, flood and the like, and the parents need to focus on post-disaster restoration.
- ⑥Parents who are engaged in job hunting or planning to start looking for a job once their child is enrolled in a nursery school.
- (7)Parents who are currently in education.

#### [Application Period]

- 1st Round: October 3 (Mon) through 31 (Mon)
- · 2nd Round: November 1 (Tue) through January 6 (Fri) 2023

#### [How to Apply]

As a general rule, an application needs to be made online. That being said, if deemed difficult to make an online application, please visit the Hikone Early Childhood division (Yojika in Japanese) and submit your application.

#### [Application Forms]

Application forms for use of a nursery school will become available from October 3 (Mon) at each nursery school, the information desk of the Hikone city hall (1st floor), each branch office of the Hikone city hall, Man Maru Hiroba (inside Viva City Hikone), Kodomo center, and Hikone Early Childhood division. The forms can also be downloadable from that day.

#### **★Flu Shots for the Elderly**

[Eligibility] Hikone residents aged 65 and older on the day of a flu vaccine, Hikone residents who have received a notice from the city due to their underlying medical conditions.

[Fee] 1,800 yen

\*If a person is living under the livelihood protection program, a flu shot will be administered for free.

[Available Period] October 1 (Mon) through Dec 28 (Wed)

[Important Notes]

- To schedule an appointment, you are required to do so with one of the designated medical facilities.
- You can see a list of medical facilities designated by the city on the website of Hikone City.
- If you have a fever of higher than 37.5 °C (99.5 °F) or any cold-like symptoms on the day of your flu shot, you will not be permitted to get vaccinated.
- If you have been diagnosed with a severe acute illness, you will not be able to receive a flu shot.
- If you have experienced anaphylaxis after a flu shot in the past, you will not be able to receive a flu shot.
- If you have experienced severe side-effects after a flu shot in the past, you will not be able to receive a flu shot.
- If you wish to get a flu show outside Hikone due to reasonable reasons, please contact the Hikone Health Promotion Division.

#### **★Preventative Measures Against Seasonal Influenza**

1. Washing hands properly.



2. Wearing a mask.



3. Maintaining a healthy lifestyle.



4. Getting a flu vaccine.



5. Keeping humidity levels within a range of 50 to 60%.



6. Avoiding crowded areas.
