[Individual Vaccination]

Appointments for booster jabs (omicron specific Pfizer) administered between Jan 4 (Wed) and 31 (Tue) are set to become open on Dec 6 (Tue) for people over 12 years old.

[Mass Vaccination]

Appointments for booster jabs (omicron specific Pfizer) administered on January 21 (Sat) and 28(Sat) at the Kusunoki center are set to begin on December 20 (Tue) for people over 12 years old.

★Year-end Nationwide Traffic Safety Campaign

★Kei Car Tax Payment Certificate Will Be No Longer Needed For A Car Inspection

Starting January 1 2023, the so-called Kei JNKS system is scheduled to be implemented nationwide, which eliminates the necessity of submitting a Kei car tax payment certificate each time you need to have your Kei car inspected by a mechanic. Please be careful that the Kei JNKS system applies to Kei cars only, and therefore, you are still required to show your tax payment certificate for a small motorcycle.

NB:

- 1: Be sure to consult your trash collection calendar, and take out the trash as instructed by December 28 (Tue).
- 2: In terms of landfill waste, you need to request a permit issued by the Hikone Sanitation center, Living Environment division, or each branch office of the Hikone city hall by December 28.
- 3: If you suspect that you have contracted COVID-19, please call 0120-935-395 to receive a test kit.
- 4: Please visit the city hall by the 28th if you need any certificates. Government-issued certificates at convenience stores will go unavailable from December 29 until January 3. Registering childbirth, death (the issue of a cremation permit is available between 8:30 and 5:15), divorce, etc. can be done at the city hall even during year-end and new-year holidays.
- 5: In terms of Hikone's public water and sewerage services, starting/cancelling the water supply and paying water bills are available at the Water and Sewerage Customer Service Center (1F, Hikone City Hall) between 9:00 and 5:00.
- 6: Payments for resident tax, national health insurance, night soil treatment, water, sewer service, and so on, can be made at banks designated by the city. (Please check the opening schedules of each bank.) If your payment bill can be paid at a convenience store, you can do so through a cashless payment app on your smartphone such as PayPay, LINE Pay, au PAY, Pay B, etc.

☆Protect Water Pipes From The Cold Of Winter

- Wrap water towels around each water pipe and cover it with a plastic bag.
- If water pipes are frozen, gently pour room-temperature water over the pipes.

 DO NOT USE HOT WATER! If you pour hot water over a frozen pipe, it could damage or even burst the pipe.
- If a water pipe bursts, shut off the water valve immediately, and call either number given below.
- It is advisable to regularly check for a water leak by taking a look at your home water meter.
