★Expansion of Fukushi Iryohi Jukyuken

Eligibility age for Fukushi Iryohi Jukyuken (financial assistance for healthcare expenses) has been expanded to cover children in up to 6th grade (until first March 31 after turning 12 years old).

Parents/guardians of new 1st graders (children born between 2016 April 2 and 2017 April 1) and new 5th and 6th graders (children born between 2011 April 2 and 2013 April 1) are required to complete the necessary procedures to receive the Fukushi Iryohi Jukyuken certificate. There is no need for parents/guardians whose children are currently in first, second, and third grade or whose children are disabled to do any paperwork to have their certificates extended.

Please be reminded that you need to bring your child's Fukushi Iryohi Jukyuken certificate when having the child checked by a doctor at a medical facility.

[Steps from Application to Issuance]

- The city will mail all the documents related to the expansion of Fukushi Iryohi Jukyuken to families with qualifying children in mid-January.
- Families who have received the documents are required to submit the application form and other requirements by February 24 (Fri) 2023.
- The city will mail the certificate to those who completed the required procedures on time in mid-March.
