[Important Notes]

• Be sure to consult your trash collection calendar, and take out the trash by following Hikone City's trash disposal rules.

- Getting certain government-issued certificates at convenience stores by using a My Number card will be unavailable from December 29 until January 3. Registering childbirth, death (the issuance of a cremation permit is available between 9:00 and 4:45), divorce, etc. can be completed at the city hall even during this year-end and new-year holiday period.
- Payments for resident tax, national health insurance, night soil treatment, water, sewer services, and other fees can be made at banks designated by the city (please check each bank's holiday schedule). If your payment bill can be settled at a convenience store, you can use cashless payment apps such as PayPay, LINE Pay, au PAY, Pay B, etc., via your smartphone.

Understanding and Support for the City's Snow Clearing Efforts

During the wintertime, road traffic conditions tend to be affected by snowfall and icy road surfaces. To minimize the negative impact on Hikone residents, the city designates the period from December 1 until March 20 as the snow clearing focus period. During this time, snow plowing and removal operations, as well as ice control measures, will be carried out on major roads with high priority.


The snow plowing and removal operations are expected to take place from midnight through early morning. That said, some operations may have to be done in broad daylight. Please also keep in mind that parking cars on the roadside is prohibited and will hinder city crews from completing snow plowing and removal operations.

[Please Help the City Deal with Heavy Snow]

The city is committed to carrying out snow and ice operations as effectively as possible. However, the city alone has its limits in clearing enough snow for all Hikone residents. For this reason, the city asks Hikone residents to clear snow off sidewalks, residential streets, and so on. When clearing snow, please dump it into a canal, trench, or drainage ditch nearby.

Protect Water Pipes From The Cold Of Winter

- $\boldsymbol{\cdot}$ Wrap towels around a water pipe and tap and, cover them with a plastic bag.
- If water pipes are frozen, gently pour room-temperature water over the pipes. DO NOT USE HOT WATER! If you pour hot water over a frozen pipe, it could damage or even burst the pipe.
- If a water pipe bursts, shut off the water valve immediately.
- It is advisable to regularly check for a water leak by taking a look at your home water meter.



Shiga Year-End Traffic Safety Campaign

During the whole month of December (the 1st through the 31st), Shiga Prefecture kicks off its Year-end Traffic Safety Campaign. Please be courteous while behind the wheel to the elderly and children. As for pedestrians and cyclists, with days becoming shorter, it is advisable to wear light-colored clothes and/or put on reflective safety stickers/tags so that it is easier to be seen in the evening and at night. Drivers, on the other hand, are reminded that driving under the influence of alcohol is a serious traffic violation.
