*The tax return site in the Hikone City Hall will be closed on Feb 20, 21, and 28 as well as weekends and holidays.

*Capacity above stands for the maximum number of tax returns can be processed each morning and afternoon.

*A pair of slippers or indoor shoes is needed at the Mizuho Bunka Center, Takamiya Bunka Center, and Toriiitmoto Community Center.

[Important Points about Tax Returns for Municipal and Prefectural Inhabitant Taxes]

- There is no need for those considering doing their taxes for income tax to file their tax returns for inhabitant taxes.
- Tax returns filed by pensioners and simple tax returns are also accepted at each tax return site.

[If any of the following applies to you, please file your tax return through the e-Tax system or at the Hikone Chamber of Commerce and Industries (4th floor)]

- Those who want to claim a special tax deduction for a home mortgage.
- Those who earn income derived from the transfer of property.
- Those who need to file a so-called blue sheet tax return form (a high-income earner through self-employment).
- Those who need to file a tax return for their own businesses for the first time.
- Those who want to claim a special tax deduction for house reinforcement for earthquakes, house modification for accessibility, and house modifications for energy efficiency.
- Those who need to file a tax return on behalf of someone who has recently passed away.
- Those who want to file tax returns for previous years (up to 5 years retrospectively).
- Those who receive pension payments under the inherited pension benefit payment system.
- Those who want to claim a tax deduction for casualty losses due to a disaster, etc.

[Please Prepare the Following Documents in Advance If Necessary]

- · Detailed Statement of Earnings and Expenses
- · Detailed Statement of Medical Expenses for a Tax Deduction

[What to Bring with You]

- Proof of the total amount of your 2024 income (pay stubs, withholding tax slips, etc.).
- Documents related to the tax deductions you wish to claim, such as a detailed statement of medical expenses, casualty losses, life insurance, earthquake insurance, national health insurance, national pension, long-term care insurance, donations, etc.
- Documents of your spouse's income if you want to claim a tax deduction for a spouse.
- A disability handbook to claim a tax deduction for a person with disabilities.
- A form of identification.
- A My Number card or a document showing your 12-digit individual numbers.

[Important Notes]

- The Hikone Tax Office is not a place for anyone to file tax returns during the tax return season.
- Depending on how crowded the tax return site becomes, the site may be closed earlier than the listed closing time.
- A waiting number slip will be distributed at the entrance of the site.
- The parking lot of the Hikone Chamber of Commerce and Industry is not free.

Ensure to Change Kei-car and Motorbike Ownership by April 1

Kei-car (light vehicle) Tax is imposed on each registered owner on April 1 every year. If you need to get ownership changed or scrap your car, ensure that you complete all the necessary paperwork by April 1.
