May Health Check-ups for Infants, Toddlers and Preschoolers

Location: Kusunoki Center (Hassaka-cho)

Starting with the health check-ups for infants and young children in April 2024, you are required to make an appointment in advance via a mobile app "母子モ(Boshi Mo)". If you come to the Kusunoki Center for your child's check-up without an appointment, you may be told to return with an appointment.

Introduction of Shingles Vaccine as Routine Immunization

The shingles vaccine can be administered to individuals who can meet either Condition A or Condition B from fiscal year 2025 to 2029 under the subsidy program for shingles shots. Please note that each eligible individual can receive no more than one series of shingles vaccination during the said period.

[Eligibility Criteria]

• Condition A: Those who are at the age of 65, 70, 75, 80, 85, 90, 95, or 100 and older at the time of vaccination in fiscal year 2025 (until March 31, 2026).

• Condition B: Those aged 60 to 64 and who have been diagnosed with HIV/AIDS *Equivalent to holding a physical disability handbook.

Live Shingles Vaccine: One Dose
 Recombinant Vaccine: Two Doses

Live Shingles Vaccine: 2,700 yen

Pneumococcal Vaccination

Those who have never got vaccinated against pneumococcal infection and can meet either "Condition A" or "Condition B" specified below are advised to get a pneumococcal shot.

[Eligibility] A: 65 years old at the time of receiving a pneumococcal shot

B: 60 to 64 years old with a heart disease, kidney disease, respiratory disease, or HIV

[Subsidy Amount] 2,660 yen

[Important Points]

- Please schedule your appointment with a health facility where the pneumococcal vaccine is administered.
- A pre-vaccination questionnaire is available at health facilities across Hikone.
- People who fall under the age group of 60 to 64 with at least one of the said medical conditions are required to apply at the Hikone Health Promotion Division.

^{*}Please be reminded that the subsidy program does not fully cover the cost of the shot.
