

INFORMATION

☆Do you have breakfast every day?

What percentage of people who don't eat breakfast in Hikone city?

Out of the Hikone citizens (over 12 years old) 21.3% of the men, 10.8% of the women don't have breakfast (shown in the figure). This rate is higher than the average of an entire Shiga prefecture. There is a high tendency that the men from 20 years old to 40 years old and the women in the 40 years old tend to be relatively high in a percentage of skipping breakfast. As for children, it was made clear that 13% of the 5th grade students in the elementary school, 16.2% of the second grade students in the junior high school don't have breakfast. (FBreakfast intakes circumstantial investigation for students in 2016 (Prefectural Education Board Health and Physical education department)



☆Have You Heard of "30 · 10 Sanmaru Ichimaru Movement"?

In April, the first month of the new fiscal year, there were a series of social parties like welcome & farewell parties, weren't there? Have you ever realized that dishes served at those parties were left untouched and ended up going to waste?

The prime purpose of "30 • 10 Movement" is to reduce the amount of leftovers, encouraging people to stay seated at least 30 minutes at the beginning of the party and 10 minutes at the end of the party to concentrate on eating the food available.

This movement originated in Matsumoto City, Nagano Prefecture in 2011, and it has been emphasized to raise awareness on the reduction of food waste.

Food waste means food that is being thrown away even though they are perfectly edible. The gross amount of food waste, according to statistics by Ministry of the Environment and Ministry of Agriculture, Forestry and Fisheries in 2015, reached 6,210,000 tons in Japan. This number includes unsold products, leftovers, expired food and etc. at retail and consumer levels.



☆The Renewal Procedure of Welfare Medical Support (except for babies & infants)

----Be sure to apply by Friday, June 30----

Current Welfare Medical Support Tickets (*Fukushi Iryohi Jukyuken*) for severely mentally or physically challenged residents and patients who go to a psychiatric hospital for mental healing (except for babies and infants) are renewed on Tuesday, August 1. If you would like to continue receiving medical support, you need to follow the procedure for renewal. Application for babies and infants who have a welfare medical support ticket is not necessary this time.

The Schedule for the Renewal

- 1 We will mail you the necessary documents for renewal at the beginning of June.
- 2 Please submit the renewal application by Friday, June 30.
- 3 We will make an examination of your income and all details included.
- 4 We will mail the Welfare Medial Support Tickets around Friday, June 21 to the people who are eligible from Tuesday, August 1.
- If you don't submit the renewal application, you will not be able to receive the support.
- If your previous year's income exceeds the allowed limit at the result of examination, you will not be able to receive the support.

In Hikone City, Welfare Medical Support (*Fukushi Iryo Josei*) is given to babies and infants, to elementary school & junior high school children, to severely mentally or physically challenged people, to single parents & their children (under 18 years old), to women who have lived by themselves for more than one year and will continue the current life-style (under 65, and 65~74 years old), to the seniors (65~74 years old) with mental or physical challenge or with lower income. If you think you re applicable, please inquire to the City National Health Insurance and Pension Division..

• Hikone City assigns a limit to the amount of the previous year's income.

☆Subsidy for Rubella Vaccine

To those who took the MMR antibody test for Rubella in Shiga Prefecture, a subsidy for the vaccination or MR vaccination against measles is granted.

• Eligibilities (All conditions must be met.)

- ①Persons who received the MMR antibody test carried out by Shiga Prefecture.
- ②Having being recommended to receive a shot against rubella and did so after the MMR antibody test.

 (After taking the MMR antibody test conducted by Shiga Prefecture from May 1st, 2017 till March 31st, 2018, you are supposed to finish the necessary shot by March 31st.)

• Amount & Number of Subsidy You will Receive

*Half the cost of vaccination is covered (up to 5,000 yen). For those who live on the Livelihood Protection Law benefits, the maximum account of subsidy is up to 10,000 yen.

*One time per person

• Documents to Submit

- *Application form for the subsidy (Available on the website of Hikone City)
- *A copy of the MMR antibody test result.
- *A copy of a medical bill issued by a medical institution

(A name of a vaccination taker, vaccination type, date and cost must be included.)

Natalia's Room (No.35) – My first "Koden-Bukuro"



On January 12th around 2:00 AM, I received the call I've been most dreading my whole life. When I picked up the phone, my cousin, who is living in Brazil, said to me in a teary voice something I could not forget. Her words are "I don't have good news. Your mother was passed away". My mother wasn't sick. She had a heart attack and passed away suddenly.

Of course the first thing I thought is that I wanted to be by mom's side. But the trip from Japan to Brazil takes around 30 hours and I wasn't able to book a ticket at that point, so I didn't make it to my mom's funeral on the next day. Eventually, I was able to take a flight a few days later and arrived in Brazil one week after my mom had passed away. When I was at the airport before taking the flight to Brazil, I had a big cry. I wondered why I had to lose my mom this way. The last time I meet her was last year on July. Even after doing this 30 hours long journey, I knew there was no way I could be able to see my mother's face on this life again. That was a really long and sad flight, and even to this day I don't wish anyone was to make this kind of journey.

After that, I thought a lot about life and death. They say the natural order is for the parents to go before their children, but I don't have many acquaintances that lost their parents on their twenty or before that age. If I count the number of acquaintances who lost their parents in a suddenly way and not because of a disease, the number is even smaller. On top of that, fortunately most of my acquaintances that are living abroad for a long time still have their parents alive and doing well. But in my case, when my mother died, not more than two years and nine months had passed away since the day I came to Japan, a very short time span. Because of all that, I still think that this outcome is very absurd and out of the "natural order of the things". When you live abroad for a long time, it's normal to worry about things like family sickness and who is going to take care of your parents when they are older, but I didn't even had the time to prepare myself for these steps. Having to confront the death of my mom right from the start is a very heart-wrenching experience that I don't really have words to explain.

As the time passes, I also have been noticing how much talking or hearing people talk about death is something really difficult for people. It doesn't matter if I am around Brazilian or Japanese people, every time I bring up this topic I can feel the people's discomfort around me and it made me very confused. Even though they say Brazilian and Japanese have totally different cultural values, I really feel now that when it comes to death, everyone around the world acts really similar.

Because of that, I've been wondering if I should write about my mom's death. But, how are we supposed to confront death if we avoid this topic? I don't think there are words to conform those who lost a loved one, but I do think now that recognizing people's feeling and accepting them is something we all can do.

After my mother died, I received from my coworkers a "koden-bukuro". A "koden-bukuro" is an envelope where people put money offerings for those who have lost a loved one. This money is usually used to cover some expenses related to the funeral of the people who passed away. In Brazil, we don't have the custom of giving people "koden-bukuro" and up to that day, I never had the chance to see one of those envelopes. I knew beforehand that in Japan there has this custom of giving money offering to those who lost a loved one, but I could never imagine that my first experience with a "koden-bukuro" would be that way. Instead of being the one who is giving a "koden-bukuro" to somebody, I was the one who was receiving it. And the reason of that was because of the passing away of my mother, which was also my best friend that cheered for me for so long. I wonder if there was a meaning to this event, too. I think I'll probably never get a satisfactory answer, but I'll keep living while confronting my mother's death.
