

★Inspect Concrete Block Walls

On June 18th, a concrete wall fell on a young girl in a recent major earthquake in Osaka. To prevent this accident from happening again, the central government and local governments have called for safety checks to all residents who have cinder-block walls on their properties. Please check the safety of every cinder-block wall within your property by the following standards.



Six Things You Should Check on Your Concrete Wall(s)

- 1, Is the height of the wall under 2.2m from the ground?
- 2, Is the thickness of the wall more than 10cm?

 (If the height of the wall is between 2m and 2.2m, the thickness needs to be at least 15cm.)
- 3, Does the wall have a counterfort that is spaced every 3.4m and higher than 1/5 of the wall above ground?
- 4, Are a footing and foundation placed under the concrete wall?
- 5, Is the wall having any cracks or leaning?
- 6, Are reinforcing steel bars used to reinforce the wall?

However, purchasing products by credit card means you have to pay for what you buy later on, as a result, you might become impulsive and wind up spending and paying more than you intend. For this, it is essential to keep an eye on how much you use your credit card.

Especially, when you use your credit card for online shopping, please be careful of the following things.

- Double check if an online store uses questioning and vague words for product descriptions, etc.
- If you see something fishy, do not buy anything from that store.
- Ensure information of conditions and terms for products and services (Ex; cancelling and returning purchases) is all legit.

★Information of Japanese encephalitis vaccination

Japanese encephalitis vaccinations have not been recommended, and then the new vaccinations have been developed. Now the vaccinations can be received as a regular one.

Regular vaccination schedule:

1st phase (3 times) the statutory age range: 3 years to 7 years and 6 months,

2nd phase (1 time) the statutory age range: 9 years to 13 years.

Special targets of Japanese encephalitis vaccination: Following person can receive the vaccinations.

The special targets of Japanese encephalitis vaccination

- ① Those who missed the opportunities of the vaccinations, born between 1998 April 2 and 2007 April 1, can receive the remaining vaccinations before 20 years old for free.
- ② Those who received the 1st phase vaccinations less than 3 times, born between 2007 April 2 and 2009 October 1, can receive the remaining vaccinations during the 2nd phase period for free.

How to receive the vaccination

Please receive the vaccination with your mother's book and health insurance card, after the reservation to medical institution.

Notes

- *Japanese encephalitis vaccinations can be received 4 times in total. Please make sure so as not to overlap.
- *Pregnant or possibly pregnant women are not allowed to receive vaccinations in principle.
- *In principle, it is needed to receive the guardians. When it is not possible, vaccination can be received with the coupon of guardian non-accompanied vaccination.

★Watch Out for Mosquitos During the Summer Season

The main virus of dengue and Zika fever is transmitted from a mosquito to a human when the mosquito bites someone who has contracted the virus and then bites another person who has not.

Not all of us get infected with the virus; however, if pregnant women become infected, there is a chance that babies with birth defects such as microcephaly will be born. On top of it, when dengue fever becomes severe, there will be bleeding spots on the skin.

Take Preventive Measures to Eliminate Mosquito Breeding Sites

Mosquitos have habits of using water to lay eggs. Try to get rid of standing water left in flowerpot trays, planters, buckets and so forth. If you eliminate this type of standing water at least once a week, you can reduce the number of adult mosquitos.

How to Prevent Mosquito Bites

When you spend some time outdoors, put on trousers and a long-sleeved shirt to cover your exposed skin, and use mosquito coils and repellents to keep some mosquitos away. When you stay indoors, prevent mosquitos from sneaking into your house by installing the screen doors, etc.

When you pay a visit to areas where mosquito-borne diseases are prevalent, watch out for mosquitos bites with extra caution.

My Most Favourite Kanji



"What's your most favourite Kanji?" That was a question I was asked by my friend the other day. Probably for Japanese people, it is a cliché question to ask because of the familiarity with Kanji since childhood; however, for me, this question was hard to answer since I spent most of my life in the world of alphabets.

So what is my most favourite Kanji? After mulling over that for a minute, I told my friend, "my most favourite is gonna be 忘 (wasu) as in 忘れる (wasureru)." Yep, my friend quickly became a bit puzzled with my answer (I bet so are you now), and my friend's reaction came as, sort of, no surprise on account of the fact that there are more than 2000 Kanji characters used in daily life. You may be also wondering why I like "忘" the most. Well, let me explain why I see this Kanji character differently from many others.

The meaning of the Japanese word "忘れる" equals "forget" in English, but by breaking it down into two parts: "心 (heart)" and "亡 (loss)", you can see this Kanji character actually signifies "something is lost from your heart."

It was an aha moment when the profundity of Kanji struck me, thanks to this clandestine message in "忘".

One of the most common reasons why a good many Japanese leaners have found Kanji so tough to master is simply it looks like a scribble which does not make any sense. Even so, once you become able to understand the logical concept of each Kanji character like "\overline{\overl

What is more, if I have to describe my experience of Japanese learning in one Japanese word, it would be "忘" as well. Forgetting is undoubtedly part of learning, and this principle firmly applies to any learning process. To take an example, one new Japanese expression or Kanji character I learnt in the past will not come out of my mouth even though I oftentimes used it. Forgetting and remembering have a strong correlation in terms of brushing up on not simply language proficiency, but any skills.

Kanji is a very interesting writing style, and I admit that my choice, when it comes to the most favourite Kanji character, is not typical. Yet, I really like "忘". So what is your most favourite Kanji?
