

[About Applying For Nursery School Mid-Year]

- The application deadline in this case is the last day of the month that is two months prior to your desired start month. (e.g.) If your desired start month is June, 2024, you need to apply by the end of April, 2024.
- In case of applying for nursery school mid-year, each applicant is allowed to choose only one desired nursey school.

 *If your application was turned down during the 1st and 2nd round application periods, you will be put on waiting list.
- If your child is accepted into the desired nursery school, you will be notified as early as possible by phone. If not, the results of your application will be notified by post.
- Once your child is put on waiting list, you will receive a child care center waiting list notice. If necessary, you can request the Hikone Early Childhood Division to issue you with the same notice.

1. Types of Nursery Schools

Nursery schools are categorized into three types: regular nursery schools, Kodomo-en (which functions as both a kindergarten and a nursery school), and regional daycare centers (which are further divided into small-scale daycare, on-site daycare, and other categories).

As a general rule, all nursery school services are provided to parents or guardians who cannot care for their children at home due to work or other valid reasons.

2. Level of Childcare Needs

The level of childcare needs is categorized into three different levels. Please refer to the table below to determine which category you are most likely to fall into when applying for a nursery school.

Children who have just turned 3 years old will be categorized into Group 2.

3. Eligibility Criteria

All applicants must be listed on Hikone City's basic resident registration as of April 1, 2025, in order to apply. This includes individuals who are certain to move to Hikone from another city by April 1, 2025

5. Childcare Services After Childcare Leave

If you wish to use childcare after your childcare leave ends, the city has implemented a system that allows you and others in the same situation to apply for a nursery school in advance. With this in mind, if your first choice of nursery school has no vacancies when your childcare leave ends, you will be notified and referred to other nursery schools based on your preferences. Please note that if no nursery school has a vacancy for your child when your childcare leave ends, your child will be placed on a waiting list. Please contact the Hikone Early Childhood Division for more details.

• If your childcare leave ends between May and November, you are required to submit your application during the 1st around of the application period. In your application please do specify that you want to use childcare after your childcare leave ends.



• If your childcare leave ends in December and later, you are required to submit your application after the 1st round of the application period.

[Important Notes]

- Each nursery school has a trial period for both parents and children. Be sure to keep this in mind when applying for childcare services after your leave ends. For example, if your leave ends in September, you should aim to start the childcare in August to accommodate the trial period.
- If you miss the application period for the May-to-November admission, your child may be put on waiting list.
- This system is applicable to those who are on childcare leave and will return to work after the end of leave.
- Your application needs proof of employment including the date your childcare leave ends as well as the date you will return to work. Please do not forget to check the box "育児休業明けで保育所を新規利用する" upon applying online.

6. Fair Screening Process

To ensure that the application screening process is conducted fairly, the city of Hikone carefully reviews all information provided by each applicant. Please be aware that there is no guarantee that your child will be enrolled in your first-choice or even second-choice nursery school.



7. Application Forms and Requirements

The following table outlines the forms and requirements needed for your nursery school application based on your childcare needs. Be sure to prepare all required documents for both parents and any grandparents under 60 living in the same household.

[Cautions]

- If you want to apply to use a nursery school just for the reasons such as "Just to watch his/her younger sibling(s) at home", "to have my child acquire social skills", "to make my child more accustomed to a social life", "to make friends", "give my child a place to play", and the like, your application will not be accepted or processed.
- If your application lacks required documents, your application will not be processed.
- If your application contains misleading and/or fraudulent information, your application will not be processed.

8. Amount of Childcare Services, Childcare Hours, etc.

The childcare services at a nursery school in Hikone are divided into two types: 11-hour full time childcare and 8-hour short time childcare. All applicants will be categorized into either full time childcare or short time childcare depending on the reason for the use of childcare.

If you wish to use the extended childcare service, be sure to speak with the nursery school where your child is enrolled. For detailed information on the nursery school's hours of operation and the cost of the extended childcare service, please refer to each school's information page.

*All children who are about to start attending a nursery school are required to go through a childcare trial period.

The length of this trial period can vary, depending on factors such as the child's age and whether this is their first time in nursery care. During the trial period, children will leave the nursery earlier than usual, and as a result, parents or guardians will need to pick them up before the school's regular closing time.

9. Application Periods and Methods

- (*1) Applicants whose reason for needing the childcare service is "Job Hunting" can file their applications during the period of the 1st round. However, their applications can only be processed during the 2nd round.
- Those who have withdrawn their child from childcare but wish to re-enroll them in a nursery school at any point during the fiscal year 2025 are required to submit their application during the first round of the application period.
- Priority will be given to applicants who submit their applications during the specified application periods. Please keep in mind that submitting your application on time does not guarantee that your child will be enrolled in any of your desired nursery schools.
- Filing applications for both a nursery school (Group 2 and 3) and kindergarten (Group 1) at the same time are prohibited, excluding Midori Kindergarten.
- Information on applications for Midori Kindergarten and St. Joseph *Kodomoen* will be provided through the 2024 September issue of Hikone Community Newsletter, and information on applications for Kinjo Kodomoen will be provided through the 2024 October issue of Hikone Community Newsletter. In terms of applications for public kindergartens, all the related information will be published through the 2024 November issue of Hikone Community Newsletter.

[How to Apply]

As a general rule, all childcare-related applications must be submitted online. For important information about the online application process, please refer to the online application platform. If you are planning to apply for the childcare service for more than one child (siblings) at the same time, make sure to submit one application per child.

- 1. Please scan the QR code or hit the link to visit the online application platform.
- 2. Next, select "彦根市電子申請サービス (Hikone Online Application Service)."
- 3. Select "令和 7 年度(2025 度)保育所等利用申込 [一斉申請] 2025 Application for Nursery Schools, etc." and then, start filling out the online application form.

If you do not have any internet access, or it is difficult for you to apply online due to the language barrier, you can submit your application in person at the Hikone Early Childhood Division (2F, Hikone Welfare Center). The said division is open from 9:00 AM to 4:45 PM on the weekday except holidays.

[What to Submit If in Person]

- Childcare Service Application From (One form per child)
- Required Documents
- Identification

10. Important Points After Accepted

The following are the important points after your application for the childcare service is accepted. Please notify the Hikone Early Childhood Division immediately if you wish to decline acceptance of the childcare service. Be careful that if you fail to notify the said division on time to decline acceptance of the childcare service you may have to bear the initial cost of the service.

- 1. If there are any changes to the information you provided when applying for childcare services, please notify either the childcare facility where your child has been accepted or the Hikone Early Childhood Division.
- If the reason for needing childcare, the amount of childcare required, or the period of childcare has changed, please notify either the childcare facility where your child has been accepted or the Hikone Early Childhood Division immediately.
- 3. If you decide to remove your child from the childcare services, it is required to do paperwork in advance at either the childcare facility or Hikone Early Childhood Division.
- 4. If your child can be supervised at home, you are required to remove him/her from the childcare facility.
- 5. Be sure to consult with the childcare facility where your child has been accepted to if he or she has food allergies.

11. Childcare Costs, Payment Methods, etc.

*How much you will have to pay for the childcare costs will be calculated by the Hikone City.

• By Direct Debit

- → Childcare related payments are automatically deducted from your bank account on a scheduled date.
- *If the scheduled payment date falls on a holiday, the payment will be deducted on the next business day.

• By Bill

- → A bill for your childcare costs will be mailed by the middle of each month, with the payment due by the end of that month.
- *If the due date (the end of the month) falls on a holiday, the payment deadline will be extended to the end of the first week of the following month.

Please note that childcare costs will be charged at the beginning of each month for the entire period your child is enrolled in the facility. If you have outstanding bills for childcare services, your asset will be legally seized to satisfy the debt, your application will be placed at the bottom of the priority list.

- The Cost of Dishes Served with School Lunches
 - 1. Parents/guardians of 3-year, 4-year and 5-year olds who are enrolled in a nursery school or Kodomo-en will be charged for dishes served with school lunches. Details of the cost of dishes vary from childcare facility to childcare facility.
 - 2. Please refer to the details of each nursery school from page 16 to page 55.
 - 3. The cost of dishes is not charged for families classified in income categories A to D1 or for a third or subsequent child from the same family.

[Direct Debit Request Form]

Parents or guardians of children aged 0 to 2 years old must submit a direct debit request form at a bank of their choosing after being accepted for childcare services by 2025 March 7 (Fri).

^{*}If those who lived abroad and applied for childcare services fail to submit required documents on time or fail to do their taxes properly, the maximum amount of childcare costs may be levied and no cost reduction system can be applied.

12. In Case of Emergency

Given the increasing frequency of disasters in recent years across Japan, it is essential for the city to establish an effective disaster prevention network to protect children during such events.

To this end, please be aware that all public daycares will be closed if an evacuation advisory level 3 or higher, a storm warning, or a special warning is issued in Hikone City, or if a seismic intensity level above 5 is recorded. For more details, please refer to the page "In Case of Severe Weather."

*Additional measures to protect school children may vary from school to school.

13. Childcare Services Outside Hikone

A nursery school outside the city of Hikone is accessible only to parents/guardians who have valid reasons for leaving their child in the care of a nursery school outside Hikone. To keep your child enrolled in a nursery school outside Hikone for more than one year, parents/guardians must complete the renewal process annually.

*Whether your child can be placed in a nursery school outside Hikone will be determined through discussions between Hikone and the city where the nursery school is located.

*Even if you complete the renewal process for a nursery school outside Hikone, there is no guarantee that your child will be permitted to continue attending the same nursery school.





FAQ Part 1

- Q. What documents are required to submit for my childcare service application if a grandfather and/or grandmother are living under the same household?
- A. Only if the grandfather and/or grandmother are under 60 years old, certain documents for them are required to submit. Be sure to check exactly what documents you need in this guidebook or contact the Hikone Early Childhood Division. If you fail to submit the required documents on time in this regard, two points will be deducted from your total score.
- Q. Do I need to prepare all the required documents for each of my children when applying for the city's childcare services?
- A. One copy of each required document is sufficient. However, please upload each required document with the online application for each of your children. For paper applications, ensure you provide a photocopy of each required document.
- Q. How can I make corrections to my online application?
- A. Log into the online application platform "彦根市電子申請サービス." Click on "申込内容照会" on the menu page.

 Scroll down the next page to locate the application form you submitted. Select the form and click the "修正する" button to make corrections.
- Q. Is it possible to enroll two or more of my children in the same nursery school?
- A. Yes. However, please keep in mind that if there are not enough vacancies at your first-choice nursery school to accommodate all your children, your second or even third-choice nursery schools will be your only options.
- Q. How soon will I be notified about the results of my application for childcare services if I apply in the middle of the current school year?
- A. When your application is accepted, you will be notified early in the month before your child starts attending the nursery school. If your application is not accepted, the city will mail you a notice indicating that your child has been placed on the waiting list, typically around the middle of the month in which you submitted your application.
 - Please be aware that the said notice is mailed only once. If you want to ask questions about your application process, please inquire of the Hikone Early Childhood Division.
- Q. Can I change the nursery school I applied for to another nursery school?
- A. Yes, but please notify the Hikone Early Childhood Division two months in advance.
- Q. Can I apply for the nursery school even if there are currently no vacancies?
- A. Yes, you can apply, but your child will be placed on a waiting list. Once a vacancy becomes available at the nursery school and your score is at the top of the list, you will be notified.
- Q. Is there a way to check the current vacancies at each nursery school?
- A. Please visit the Hikone City's official website or contact the Hikone Early Childhood Division in person or by phone.



- Q. Are single-parent households eligible for free access to childcare services?
- A. Single-parent households subject to resident tax may bear the cost of childcares services.

[In case you live with a grandfather and/or grandmother]

- If a single mother or single father is already subject to resident tax, the resident tax amount for the grandparents will not be considered.
- If a single mother or single father is exempt from resident tax, but either a grandfather or grandmother is subject to resident tax, the amount of resident tax will be taken into consideration. Additionally, if recent pay slips or other forms of proof of income for grandparents are submitted, they will be used to determine whether childcare costs can be waived.
- Q. My child has turned three years old during the current school year. Am I eligible for the free childcare system?
- A. No. Children who are two years old at the beginning of the current school year (April 1st) will remain as two-year-old children even if they turn three during the school year. Therefore, the free childcare system is not applicable.
- Q. Where can I pay my bill for childcare?
- A. You can pay your bill at any bank or JP Bank office across Hikone, as well as at the childcare facility where your child is enrolled. Additionally, payments can be made at the Hikone Early Childhood Division, Hikone City Hall, and its branch offices.
 - *We suggest that you should pay your childcare expenses via direct debit.
- Q. How are the childcare costs calculated if there are siblings in elementary school?
- A. Please refer to the table below. If your family is classified as A or B, the city's childcare services can be provided free of charge.
